Activity Benefits

Welcome to a peek at Morningstar Day-care's program. We operate from 7:30 am -5:30 pm Monday thru Friday. Our fun and knowledgeable staff are ready for what each new day brings. Our day is full of inventive, imaginative, & colorful ideas forwarded by the children, and expanded on by the staff = Learning = Fun! Play is children's work! As the children explore the environment, they learn about themselves, others and their ever-expanding world.

BLOCKS-develop motor skills through grasping, reaching, lifting, balancing - emotional satisfaction—creativity—cooperation—hand/eye coordination—problem solving skills

ART-expression of ideas, feelings - use fine motor skills—child learns to make choices, sensory experience, develops creativity, imagination, and problem solving.

DRAMATIC PLAY—use of imagination, language skills, emotional release, social skills, role playing, helps children work through problems and experiment with solutions.

SAND & WATER PLAY- sensory experience, emotional release, soothing, social interaction. Pre-math skills (counting, spatial relations) eye/hand coordination.

SCIENCE- understanding our world,

new experiences, new concepts.

PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES- large muscle development, social interaction, stimulates the imagination, creates spatial awareness, releases energy, builds rhythm, coordination.

PLAYDOH- develops creativity using 3-D medium tension reaser, provides satisfaction, sensory, fine motor skills.

MANIPULATIVES- develops hand/eye coordination, problem solving, making things make sense, sorting and matching.

LITERATURE- develops vocabulary, listening skills, creativity, attention span fun!
